Hong Kong Aqua Ball Summer Course 2026-27

Hong Kong Aqua Ball Summer Course 2026-27 is organized by the Hong Kong China Swimming Association "HKGSA" and subvented by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department. It is held year-round and divided into 5 phases starting from June 2026 to March 2027 and 2 months for each phase.

This course is to introduce children the basics of Water Polo which included head-up sprints, passing, shooting, egg-beater (treading water), basic game structure and rules.

The coaches are the current / former Hong Kong China Water Polo Team members who possess valid Water Polo Coach Certificates. Participants with outstanding performance will be invited to join the Learn Water Polo Course programme or promoted to the Hong Kong China Water Polo Junior Squad once he/she reaches the age of 13.

Requirements

1. Aged 8-12
2. Able to pass water test of swimming 100m freestyle and 100m breaststroke continuously
