Re: Hong Kong Open Swimming Championships 2025

The association has received an email from Victoria Park Swimming Pool regarding the safety issues of the upcoming Hong Kong Open Swimming Championships 2025.

In order to avoid any obstruction of the fire access route at the spectator stand again, the width of 1500mm should be maintained at the corridor of spectator stand at all time which requested by Fire Services Department.

Furthermore, all participants including swimmers, coaches, officials and parents shall abide by the "Terms and Conditions of Hire of LCSD Public Swimming Pools" and the Public Swimming Pools Regulation (Cap. 132BR) as listed below for your reference.

Terms and Conditions of Hire of LCSD Public Swimming Pools (https://www.lcsd.gov.hk/en/common/images/b5/doc/swimpool_terms_e.pdf):

Security, Safety and Hygiene

17. The Hirer shall provide sufficient attendants and stewards to supervise and ensure the safety and orderly conduct of all persons in the swimming pool during the period of hire. The Hirer shall follow the advice and/or directions of the government representatives regarding the control of the swimming pool and its precinct if spectators are to be admitted in the swimming pool during the period of hire.

18. The Hirer shall be responsible for the conduct and safety of the people participating in the activity organised by the Hirer in the hired facilities ("Participants").

Public Swimming Pools Regulation (Cap. 132BR)

4.General Offences

No person, within a swimming pool or the precincts thereof, shall do any act which is likely to endanger, obstruct, inconvenience or annoy any person;

Warning letter will be issued to those swimmers who are found not complying with the rules and regulations, subject to penalty (such as suspension) as decided by HKGSA.
