Dear swimmers,

Nomination and selection for Hungarian Open, Budapest 2026 and the 20th Asian Games Aichi-Nagoya 2026 – Artistic Swimming

We are pleased to inform you that there are two overseas upcoming competitions this year, including Hungarian Open, Budapest 2026 ("HUN") and the 20th Asian Games Aichi-Nagoya 2026 – Artistic Swimming ("AG"). The Hong Kong China Artistic Swimming Team will participate in the following events:

- 1) Hungarian Open, Budapest 2026 (2nd – 5th July 2026)
- 2) The 20th Asian Games Aichi-Nagoya 2026 – Artistic Swimming (26th – 28th September 2026)

Remarks:

- 1) *Selected candidates are required to participate in both overseas competitions.*

We are now inviting athletes to join in the Selection Trial for the HUN and AG which will be scheduled for **21st March 2026 (Saturday) from 1800-2200 hours at Kowloon Park Swimming Pool**. The selection is open for Artistic Swimming National Squad members.

All nominees must comply with the followings:

- 1) Hong Kong SAR Passport holder;
- 2) Registered swimmer (AS) in year 2025/26 & 2026/27 of HKGSA;
- 3) Fulfill and comply with HKGSA eligibility rules;
- 4) Comply with eligibility code as set out by the Olympic Council of Asia and SF&OC;
- 5) Provide competition results (ranked top 3) in International Competitions between the period 1st January 2023 – 15th March 2026;
- 6) Must reach the age of 15 (born on 31st December 2011 or before);
- 7) Must attain 80% attendance between September 2025– February 2026.

Selection Criteria:

- 1) Based on the result of selection trial;
- 2) Based on athletes' performance in International Competitions in 2023-2026;
- 3) Past participation in Asian Games, National Games, Asian Championships and National Youth Games will be considered;
- 4) Squad coaches' recommendation will be considered.

Selection Event:

- 1) Technical Team Elements (According to World Aquatics Rules 2022-2025)
- Ranked Top 10 in the selection trail
- 2) Duet Technical Elements (According to World Aquatics Rules 2022-2025)

Interested athletes should submit the following documents to HKGSA office by post and email on or before **16th March 2026 (Monday) at 1500 hours:**

- 1) HKSAR Passport Copy (**The validity must be at least SIX months from the date of departure**);
- 2) Swimmer Information Sheet;
- 3) International Competition Results (ranked top 3) in 2023-2026 with supporting documents

Please note that the Artistic Swimming Committee has the sole and absolute discretion to the final shortlisted team selection and participation of each athlete in events. Incomplete nomination or late submission will not be accepted under any circumstances. Please ensure that the nomination documents are completed in full by **16th March 2026 (Monday) at 1500 hours.**

Each selected athlete **must** attend the Training Camp organized by HKGSA to prepare for the Asian Games (if applicable) and **must** achieved 90% attendance in Squad Training after selection from March 2026 onwards. Otherwise, her eligibility will be revoked and she will be replaced by reserve athlete.

For the Asian Games, HKGSA is only responsible for shortlisting the swimmers based on the nomination and selection criteria mentioned above and put forward to SF & OC for consideration. Please be reminded that the selections and decisions made by SF & OC shall be final.
